

Regarding the January 20, 2011 Notification of Affordable Rental Housing Applications Proposed for Hidden Valley Estates, located at the NEC of Veterans Memorial Dr. and Dewalt Road in Harris County, Texas, Harris County does not maintain a list of neighborhoods. We also find the proposed apartment complex to be inconsistent with the Harris County Affordable Multi-Family and Senior Apartment Concentration Policy (copy of the policy is enclosed with this letter), which was approved by Commissioners Court on July 9, 2008 (revised). The proposed complex has an average occupancy rate less than 90% within a three (3) mile buffer of its location and therefore is inconsistent with the Concentration Policy.

Accordingly, the building of any additional apartment complexes in the area of the NEC of Veterans Memorial Dr. and Dewalt Road in Harris County, Texas is inconsistent with the 2008-2012 Harris County Consolidated Plan. Our opposition to new tax-credit or bond-financed projects for this area will stand until it is proven that the area can support additional units. 


